I have thought for some time would write. This a.m. I am looking through the "Black box" and at the old letters from Scotland. They are from Liverpool dated Nov. 6, 1849 to ~~Wm~~ Peter Ralston from father John. Belfast Feb. 5, 1863 to Peter Ralston from his son-in-law William Fleming. It tells of the death of his wife Tues. Jan. 27. Another to Peter Ralston signed Wm & Elizabeth Fleming dated July 30, 1850. A copy of the will of Peter Ralston dated Dec. 8, 1877. Belfast July 22, 1881 to Cousin from John Fleming. One dated July 16, 1876 to Uncle signed

Andrew Balston. Also a letter from Lawrence Hans, Aug 22, 1878 to wife & family signed Thomas Balston. Another with heading off of it but from Lawrence signed Peter. Another dated wed. morning 28th 1878 signed Peter Balston and written to son.

Thurs. a.m. Will try to get this finished today.

We have been having so much cool, rainy weather this spring. Doesn't seem possible is near middle of June.

William is in Mo. visiting now. Uncle William came out May 30 and went back the next day. Bill went along. Will be home first of next week I expect. James didn't go. He will go later
